"There is a possibility that I am looking for another kind of 'order' in conceiving such chaotic constructions. To me, 'justifiability' is merely a trick in terms of orders on a superficial level. I see the process of creating paintings as an exploration of special connections among chaotic pieces, which is under control by my consciousness and balance." - Fu Site

GAWA is honored to present 'Forking Paths', a solo exhibition from Chinese-French artist Fu Site presenting his paintings from recent years. Located in our Shanghai showroom, the exhibition is curated by senior curator and art critic Joseph Cui from Paris, France.

Fu Site is best known for extracting and reorganizing seemingly counterfactual yet justifiable scenes from ubiquitous media and characters of the real world. In Fu's paintings, images of fragmented architecture, portraits, and landscapes, all come together to form layers of stories and narrative scenes. By eradicating the significance of the reality with fabricated constructions, the artist creates another kind of 'reality', with the visual elements in the paintings usually expressed through fragments or abstraction.

The paintings in the exhibition offer the strong presence of narrative scenes and storytelling. Fu finds inspiration for his characters through different combinations of fragments and space on the canvas. The many details, while muted, create intimate and hidden tensions as well as dramatic conflicts. These paintings demonstrate the coexistence of contradictions by juxtaposing entity and fragmentation, order and chaos, as well as light and gloom, creating a strong visual impact for the viewer. Meanwhile, the parallels and intersections between reality and fantasy, with multiple layers overlapping external space with internal secrecy, suggest a touch of strangeness within familiarity, mystery within revelation. By providing space for thinking and imagination, Fu's paintings allow the viewer to fully interact with the ideas and develop their own unique interpretation.

About the Artist

Born in Zhuanghe, in Liaoning Province, Fu Site received his BFA from Tsinghua University in 2006 and continued his studies in France the same year. He also holds MFA degrees from the École des Beaux-Arts de Versailles (2011) and École Supérieure d'Art du Nord-Pas de Calais (2014). Since 2014, Fu has had two solo exhibitions and numerous group exhibitions in Paris. His oeuvre has received a number of awards in France.

About the Curator

Joseph Cui is a French-Chinese curator and art critic. He has lived in France since 2002, and received a PhD degree from the Université Paris Sorbonne-Paris IV with a major in Comparative Literature. Cui also studied with François Cheng of the Institut de France, Zhao Wuji, and Zhu Dequn. Cui founded the VIA Paris Contemporary Art Association in 2013, and has held many events for Asian art masters in Paris and throughout France, supported by the French Presidential Palace and the China National Embassy in France. Cui has been invited multiple times to lecture at schools including the Academy of Arts & Design in Tsinghua University, Peking University, Xi'an Academy of Fine Arts. Cui also organizes tours for French artists to create, exhibit, and collaborate in places such as Shanghai, Ningbo, Changsha, Shenzhen, and Dezhou in China.
